# <u>Unit 6</u> <u>Final Assessment: Research Paper</u>

## Due Friday April 12, 2019

For this unit, your final assessment will take the form of a formal research paper. You may choose any topic relating to World War II that you want, but remember, it needs to be specific. For example, you cannot simply write a paper about Adolf Hitler. What will you be specifically researching in relation to Hitler? I have already met with most of you (unless you were absent last week) to help solidify these topics. **Remember to stay specific** otherwise you will end up writing way more than you need to.

#### **Expectations / Requirements**

This unit is focused on the *history* proficiency. This means I will be looking closely at your ability to effectively use primary and secondary resources to help prove the thesis of your research paper. I will also be looking at your ability to use tools of *inquiry* when you are creating the questions that guide your research as well as your ability to answer them.

Your final paper must meet the following guidelines:

- Has a cover page with your paper's title, your name, your class and block, and the due date
- A minimum of 5 pages in length (this does not include your cover page or your reference page)
- A reference page with properly formatted citations
- A minimum of 5 reliable references (this means no wikipedia, books and databases are your friend!)
- Size 12, Times New Roman font, Double spaced
- Your paper will be due by Friday, April 12

#### **Formatting Guide**

- Title Page: Centered, middle of page, size 12, Times New Roman font, single spaced
  - Title of your paper (try to have some fun with it)
  - Your full name
  - Your class / block ("Modern World History, Blue/Gold #)
  - The due date (April 12, 2019)

- Alphabetically listed
- Single spaced
