Unit 8: Final Choice Project

For the final project of the year you will be examining the topic of economics from one of a few different perspectives. Below are the three available options, but as always, if you have a different idea, run it by me and I bet we could find a way to make it work.

Option 1: Community Service

Perform at least 8 hours of community service and document it. You can provide pictures, a signed letter from a volunteer organizer, video, etc. And then write a brief (1-2) pages reflection on how volunteer work benefits our economy.

Option 2: Research Paper

Write a 3-5 page research paper about the significance of volunteer work in history. You can look at America during the great depression, major disaster cleanup efforts like the tsunami relief efforts of 2004 and 2011, volunteer efforts in war torn countries, etc.

Option 3: Personal Economics

Prepare a personal budget for your future.

First, pick a career and research the required training and salaries.

Second, find real house or apartment listings, car loans, grocery shopping expenses, etc. and determine what it would cost you to live per month.

Third, describe how economics will play a part in your daily life in a 1 page write up.
